Lorimer



Lorimer is a high yielding, early maincrop crisping variety.

It is resistant to PCN (G. Rostoch), splitting, potato virus A, skin spot and spraing. This variety also shows moderate resistance to late blight, common scab and leaf roll virus.

In common with its Olympus parent, it exhibits strong resistance to low temperature sweetening. This results in pale fry colours being maintained throughout a long storage period. A related feature is a very low level of acrylamide produced during processing.
