Revie is an attractive particolour table variety, producing bold tubers with a bright skin finish.

It exhibits strong resistance to PCN (G. Rostoch), spraing, potato virus A, mechanical damage and silver scurf. This variety also has some resistance to late blight, blackleg, scab and dry rot.

It has produced excellent yields when grown in the Canaries and in other hot climates.
