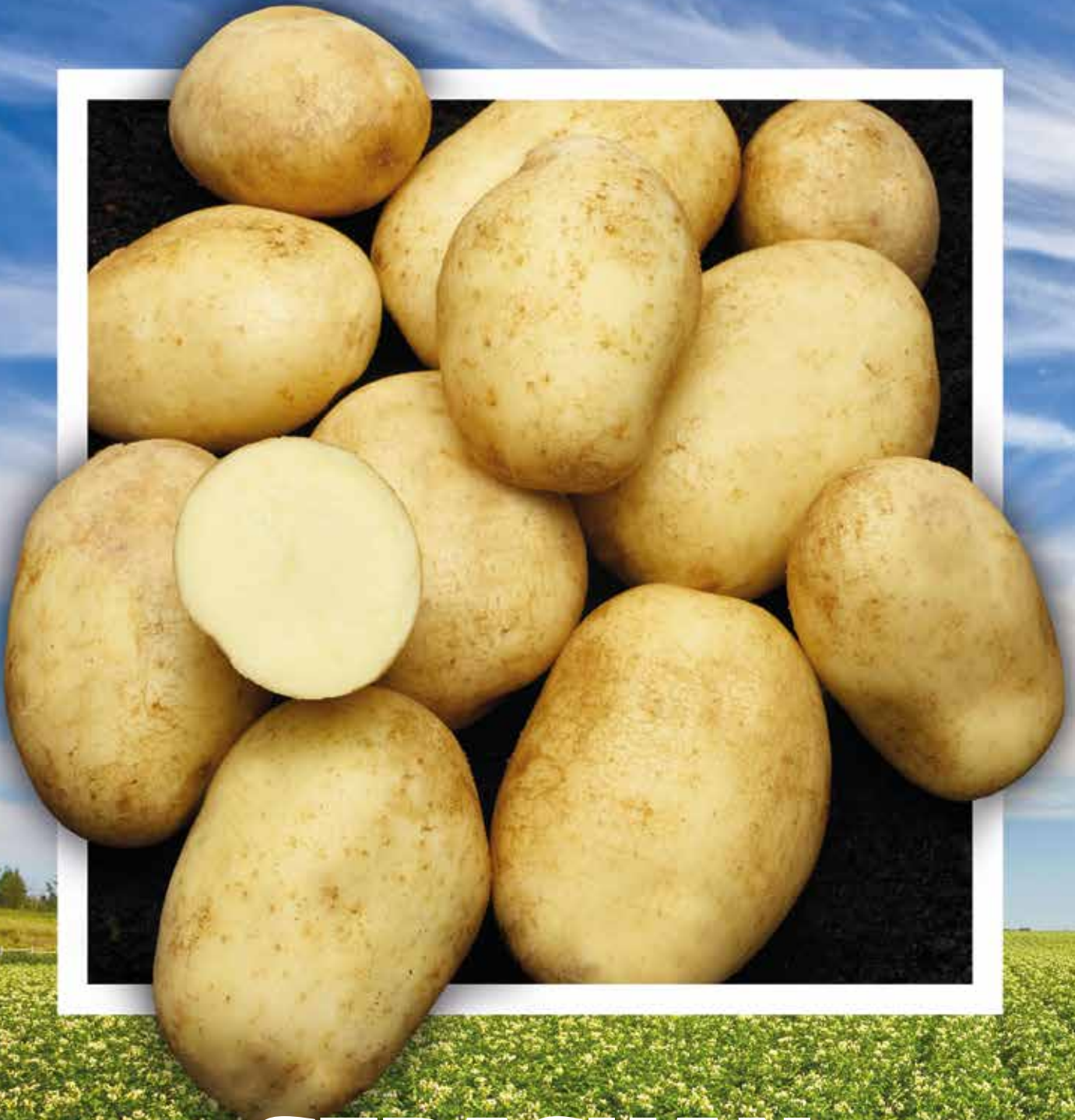

Strachan



Strachan is a high yielding, maincrop variety, suitable for both crisps and chips.

This variety is resistant to spraing, external damage, skin spot and black dot. It also shows some resistance to late blight, common scab and dry rot.

In common with its Olympus parent, it exhibits strong resistance to low temperature sweetening. This results in pale fry colours being maintained throughout a long storage period.

Origin	Olympus x 98-HIG-16.4
Maturity	Maincrop
Tubers	Long oval tubers, white skin, cream flesh
Consumer Quality	High dry matter variety suitable for crisp and chip production
Agronomic Features	Low input requirements and can be stored for extended periods

Tuber late blight	6	Leaf roll	6
Common scab	6	Black dot	8
Dry Rot (<i>F. coeruleum</i>)	6	Skin spot	9
